

SPRING Lettuce

4 rows staggered, 10 inches apart
12 seedlings per row/ 48 seedlings per bed.
Spring planting April 25, Days to maturity 40
Harvest all spring lettuce in early June.

SUMMER Pepper

2 rows staggered, 18 inches apart,
6 plants per row/ 12 plants per bed
Summer planting May 16, Days to maturity 65 days for green /85 days for red
Install 6 stakes for pepper trellis.
Inter plant the pepper seedlings amongst existing lettuce bed as shown in diagram. Add first row of twine near the base of the plant sandwiching the seedling between the twine. As plant grows and additional layers of twine to give pepper support. Harvest peppers continuously until the beginning of September. Pull out all pepper plants, remove stakes and fill bed with fall spinach .

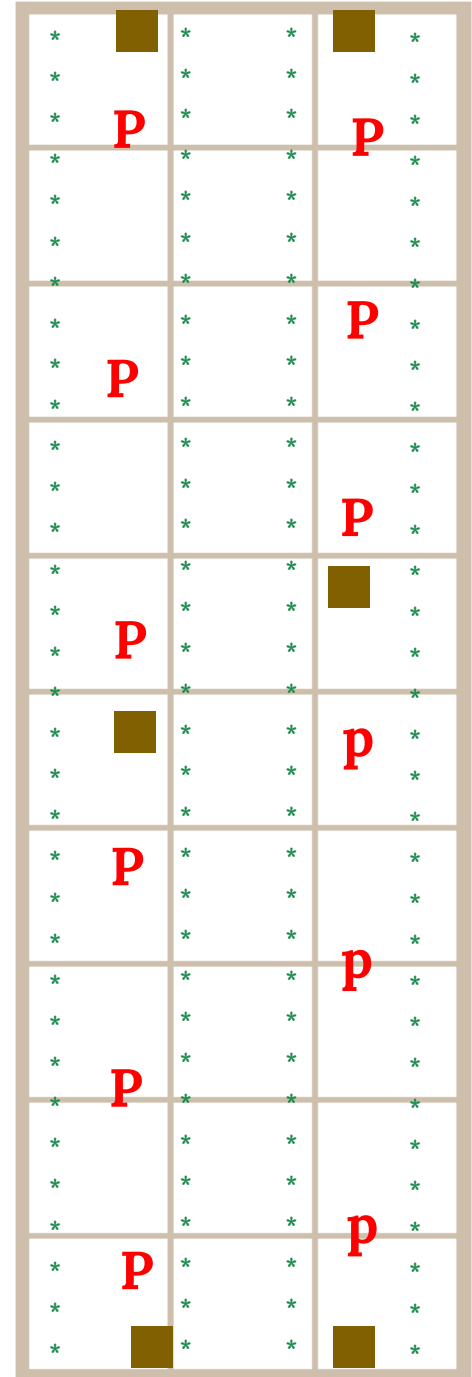
FALL Spinach

4 rows staggered, 4 inches apart,
32 plants per row/ 128 plants per bed
Fall planting early September
Days to maturity 39

NOTE—Start the season off by installing 2 rows of trellising for peppers. Create trellising using 6 stakes and garden twine. Stake placement as shown

on graph =
