

### SPRING Spinach seedlings

4 rows staggered, 4 inches apart, 1/2 inch deep  
 32 plants per row / 128 plants per bed  
 Spring planting March 25  
 Days to maturity 39  
 Harvest the spinach thru the end of May before it bolts.  
 Add a trellis and replant bed with summer tomatoes.

### SUMMER Tomato seedlings

1 row staggered under trellis, 24 inches apart  
 4 plants per row / 4 plants per bed  
 Summer planting May 16  
 Days to maturity 64  
 Stagger 4 plants in a row between trellis to support tomatoes. Add first row of twine near the base of the plant sandwiching the seedling between the twine. As plant grows and additional layers of twine to give tomatoes support. Harvest continually until beginning of September. Pull out tomato plants, remove stakes and fill bed with fall salad turnips.

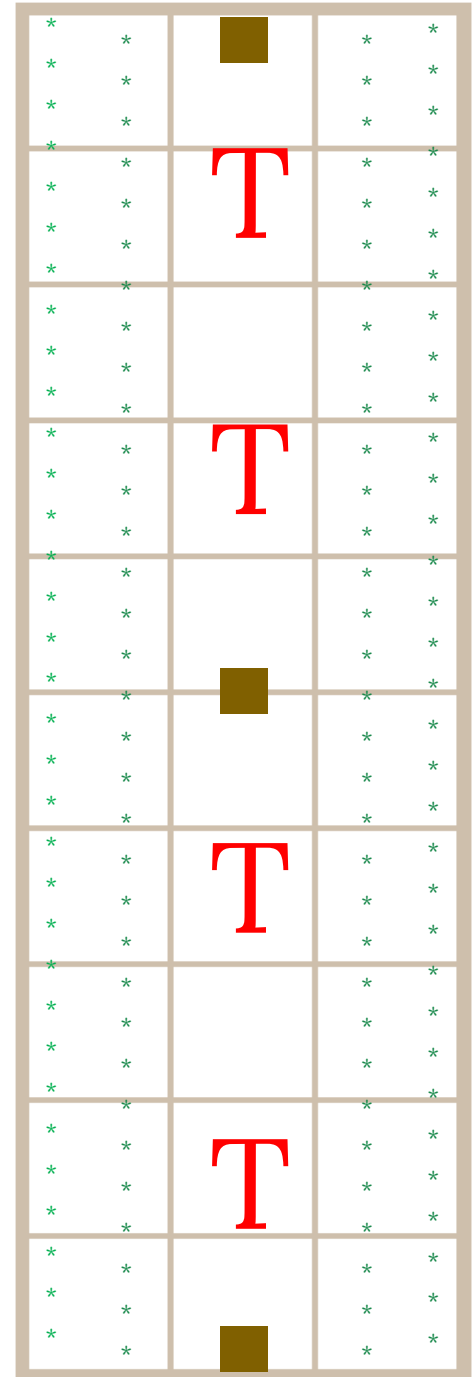
### FALL Salad Turnip seedlings

3 rows staggered, 6 inches apart  
 16-21 seedlings per row / 64 plants per bed  
 Fall planting estimated early September  
 Days to maturity 38
